Imagine I have one of the sorriest cars on the road in the State of Tennessee. It's ugly, unsafe, filthy inside and out, and the only thing worse than the way it looks is the way it runs. You can not only hear me coming from across town but see me coming by the tower of smoke. I have to stop daily to fill up the oil and check the gas. People don't go on church outings because they're afraid I'll be a driver and they might have to ride with me. Then one day, at great expense to yourself, you come

and tell me, I want to give you a new car—the safest, most reliable, nicest looking car available today. In order to have it, you have to accept it from me, and give up your old car. Should I let pride keep me from admitting the sorry state of my old car, so that I'm unwilling to give it up? Do you want me to repair and wash the old one before I accept the new one? No, you just want me to give it up and take the new one, so you can haul it off. By giving up the old one, have I somehow earned the new one, so that it's not really a gift from you, but something I deserve? Of course not. Being willing to hand over and give up the old car in order to receive the new one is... repentance. Jesus comes and says, "You turn to Me from your old, guilty, selfish, sin-stained, hell-bound life, and I'll give you a new eternal one in Me." But you, every one of you, have to be willing to turn from the old sinful, selfish life you have to receive it. "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand!" (Matt. 4: 17).

In the morning service this Sunday we'll turn to Romans 2: 17 – 29, where Paul warns us to look carefully at your own heart—not around at everybody else's, but inwardly at your own—and be certain that you do not just have appearance without reality, form without substance, a statement on your religious resume without the actual experience with Christ that it should represent. On Sunday night we'll look at Mark 4: 26 – 29, a parable unique to Mark, that teaches us how important it is that we depend on the Lord. Don't miss what the Lord's doing here!

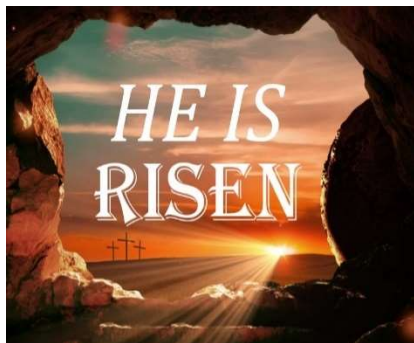


AWANA NEWS

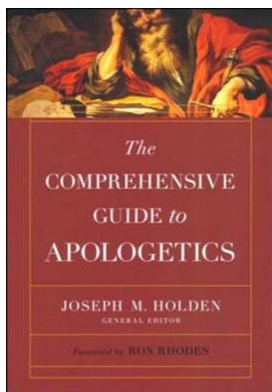
