Sharing the Word, Loving the People, Living for the King



Suppose that you're in the operating room having one of those surgeries where you're awake and alert while it's taking place. About halfway through the surgery, you hear the surgeon say, "Well, phooey. I forgot to wash my hands before we started!" Does that matter to you? He's mostly clean; it's not that important, is it? Or what if you hear a nurse say, "I had to come straight here from working in my garden; I'll change out of these dirty clothes after this procedure." Or maybe, "Well, it looks like they didn't make it in here to clean this operating room again last night!" What can a little dirt hurt? Cleanliness matters in surgery. Allowing the Lord to keep our lives clean—holy, free from the infection of sin—is not optional, not to be neglected or done halfway. Sin is contagious and deadly and spreads rapidly when left untreated. When the Holy Spirit convicts you of sin in your life, you need to confess it and let Him turn you away from it. Israel does that in Ezra 10, and their motivation is not just to avoid the consequences but to honor the God who's been so good to them, the God who's shown them such blessing and goodness only to have them transgress in return. That's our motivation still. You don't need a surgeon who doesn't worry about washing his hands, and neither the Lord nor the world needs Christians who don't worry about dealing with the dirt in their lives.

This Sunday morning we return to our study of Hebrews and we'll look at the much-discussed and often debated passage in chapter 6, verses 4 – 8. In the evening service, we'll turn to Exodus 2: 11 – 15, a fascinating picture of how God molds and shapes and trains us to carry out His purpose. Who, or what, you worship, changes your heart and shapes your life, so join us this week to worship the Living God who's worthy of it.

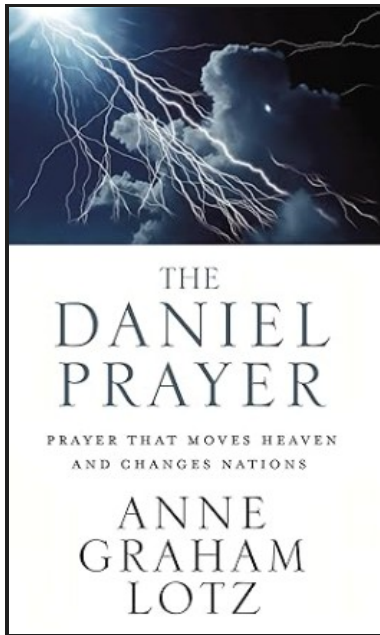

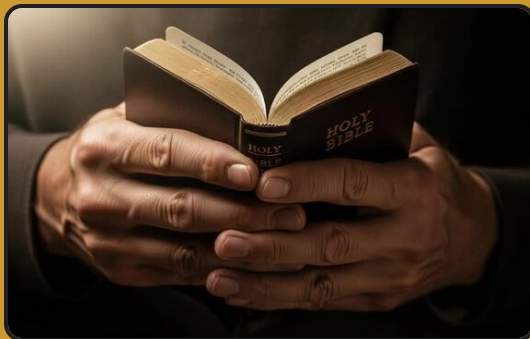
The Daniel Prayer
