Robert Hastings wrote that “tucked away in our minds is a vision. We see ourselves on a long train trip, watching the scenery pass by the windows: cars on a distant highway, children waving at a crossing, cattle on a hillside, corn across the fields, cities and villages. But uppermost in our minds is the final destination. On a certain day, at a certain hour, we will pull into the Station. Bands will be playing and flags will be waving. Once we get there so many wonderful dreams will come true and the pieces of our lives will finally fit together. But in the meantime we pace the aisles, waiting, waiting, waiting, for the Station. When we reach the Station, that will be it, we cry. When I’m 18. When I buy that new car. When I put the last kid through college! When I pay off the mortgage, when I get a promotion, when I retire, I will live happily ever after. Sooner or later we have to realize that there is no Station, no one place to arrive once and for all. The true joy of life is the trip. The station is only a dream, and it constantly outdistances us. Psalm 118:24 says, ‘This is the day the Lord has made, and we will rejoice and be glad in it.’ ...So, stop pacing the aisles and counting the miles. Life must be lived as we go along. The final destination arrives soon enough, and then ‘one of these days’ turns into ‘none of these days.’” Use the one day God has given you—today—to walk with Him and know the life He wants to give you.

This Sunday is Father’s Day, and in the morning service we’ll consider what Deuteronomy 6: 1 – 19 tells us about faithful fathers. In the evening service we’ll return to Exodus and, in 2: 11 – 25, learn some lessons from the wilderness. This Sunday, what will your choices reveal about your priorities?

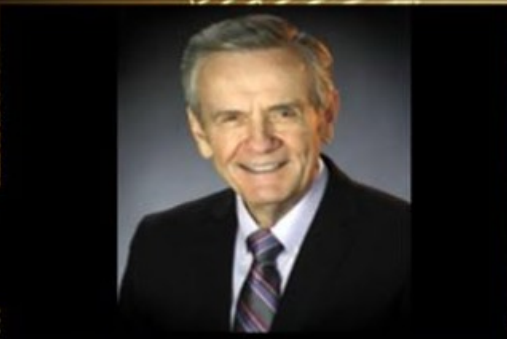

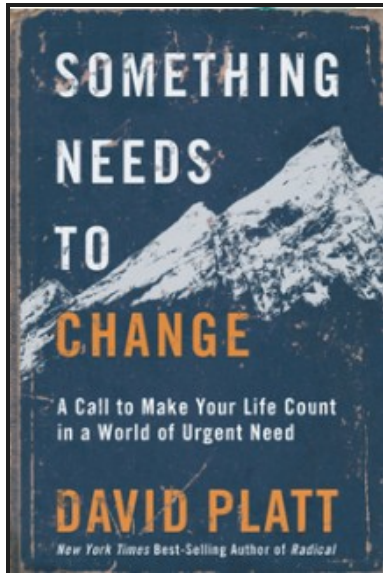

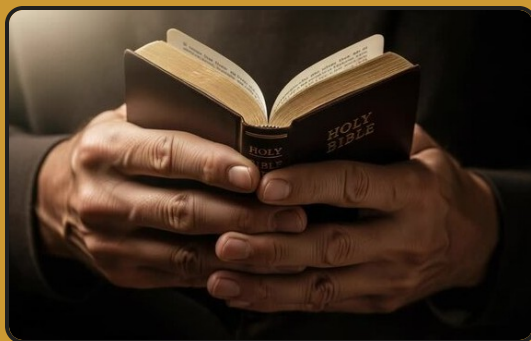


Something Needs to Change
