Imagine we go to lunch one day and I lose a large drop of sweet and sour sauce onto my shirt and tie. I say, “Well, it’s OK. Cindy has a Tide pen in her purse, and we have a washing machine and detergent at home. Nobody wants these things to happen, but sometimes they do and they can be handled.” Now imagine a different scenario. We’re at lunch and you see me at the buffet intentionally dipping my tie into the bowl of sweet and sour sauce. And I say, “It’s fine. Cindy has a Tide pen in her purse, and we have a washing machine and detergent at home.” At the table, I occasionally take a forkful and rub it on the front of my shirt. Again you inquire and I say, “It’s nothing to worry about, Cindy...,” and you jump in and finish, “I know, Tide pen in her purse, and washing machine and detergent at the house.” Meanwhile, you resolve never to go to lunch with me again, even if I pay for it. What is the difference between those pictures? Why is one unfortunate, to be avoided but not out of the ordinary, while the other is very disturbing behavior? The purpose of Tide pens, washing machines and detergent is to help you deal with the dirt and stains you try to avoid, but that do happen occasionally in life. Their purpose is not to allow you purposefully to wallow in dirt, or happily, intentionally stain your clothes. Christians at times will stumble into sin. God can clean up and turn you from any stain, but He does not intend for us just to keep happily, intentionally dipping our lives in sin, presuming on Him to forgive us. “Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not!” (Romans 6: 1).

This Sunday morning we return to Hebrews. In chapter 6, verses 9 – 12, we come to a passage that tells us about one of the greatest blessings and sources of strength we have in the Christian life. Be here and find out what it is! On Sunday evening, we’ll turn to Exodus 3: 1 – 12. God speaks to Moses in that passage, and we’ll learn from it how He still speaks to His people today. Don’t miss it for the world!

Let us take a few weeks to read, meditate and claim the essential importance of the "Fruit of the Spirit" in Galatians 5:22-23. When we are born physically, we have the characteristics of the works of the flesh, however; praise the Lord, when we are saved, reborn spiritually, we are given a new character, that crucifies the flesh and we are indwelt with the "Fruit of the Spirit".

So let us walk in the "Fruits of the Spirit" and no longer desire to walk in the works of the flesh, for we are now in the Light, the Light of the World, Jesus Christ!

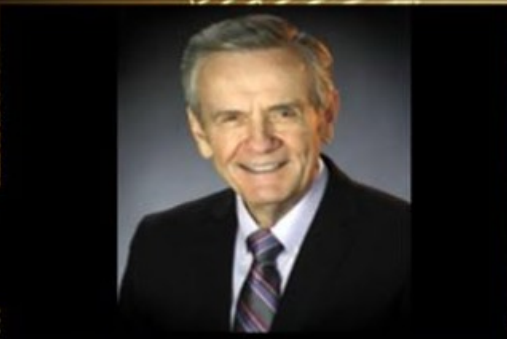

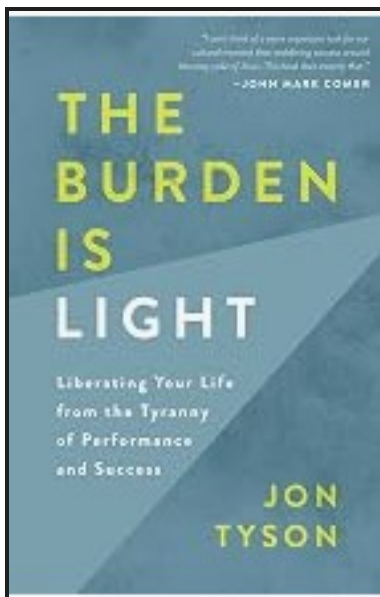

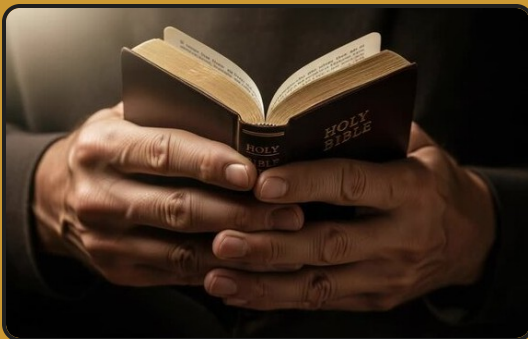
The Burden Is Light
