the woods and a cornfield that no longer exists. Looking back, I think my dad wanted me to know that it's important to keep your promises. Even if it's late and you're half-asleep in your underwear in the recliner, you need to keep your promises. He also wanted me to know that I could trust him to keep his promises. That helped prepare me for the day when I would come to know my Heavenly Father, who always keeps His promises. At the end of his life, Joshua reminds Israel what countless others have experienced, that "of all the good things which the Lord your God spoke concerning you... all have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed." Keep your promises, and know that you can trust God to keep His. Now—is it bedtime yet?

This Sunday morning we'll thank the Lord for our nation, and then in Ezra 5 be reminded that even when circumstances seem to suggest otherwise, God is most definitely in control. 
They're Ba-ack - the Choir Returns!


