It would be easy to go out in a flash of glory; it's harder to live the Christian life little by little over the long haul.” A. W. Tozer said, “The Bible recognizes no faith that does not lead to obedience, and no obedience that does not come from faith.” Does the Bible recognize yours, by those little acts of love, 25 cents at a time every day?

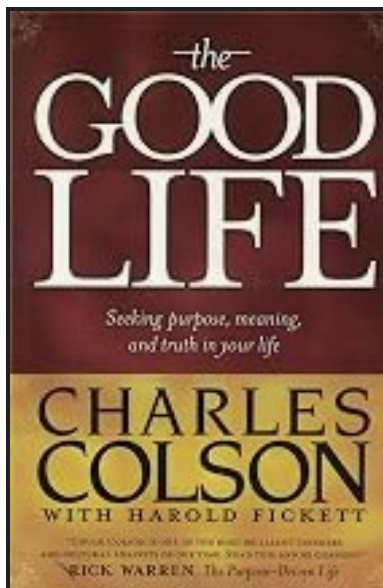

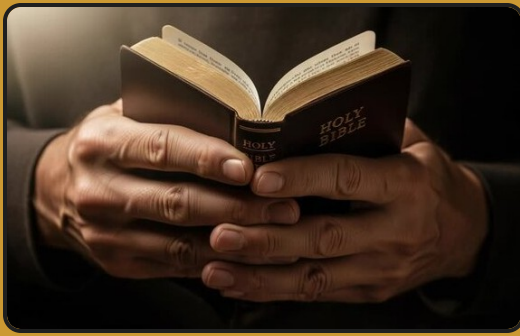


The Good Life

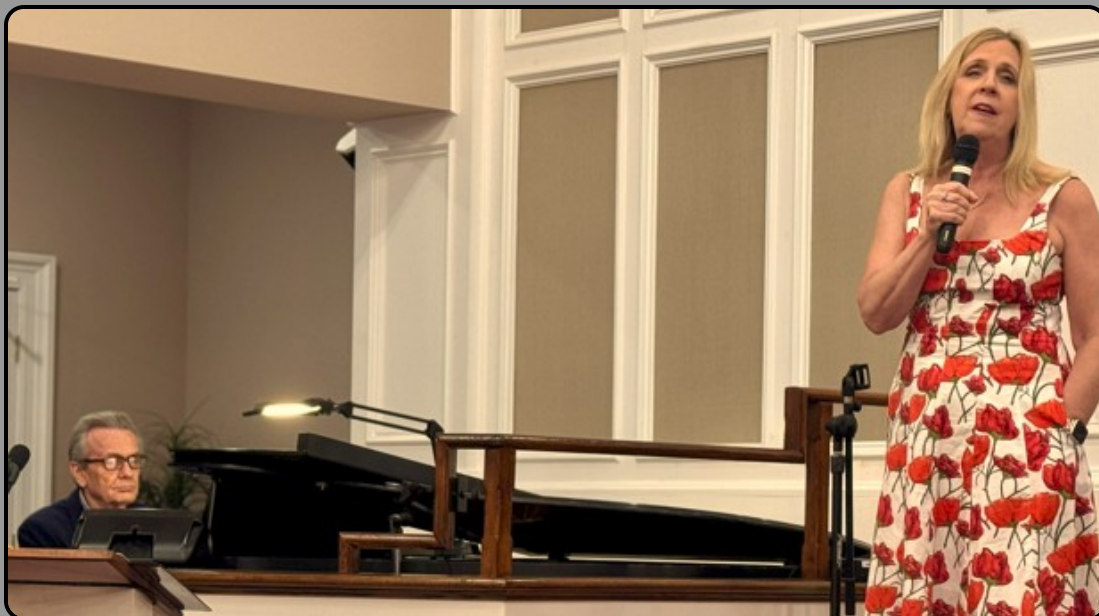
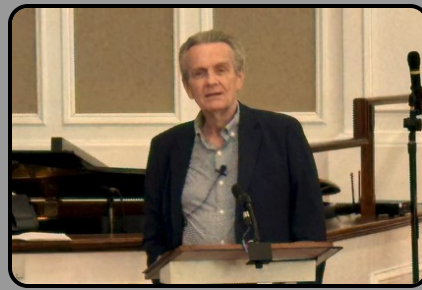
