"Why would anyone stay in the Southern Baptist Convention?", asked someone outside the SBC on social media last week. You might well wonder, since disputes, controversy, and ungodly attacks on godly people are all you seem to hear recently. But for me, the answer's easy. First, we have 3,610 international career missionaries and 2,218 North American missionaries, many of whom serve in dangerous and/or unchurched areas. I have never met an SBC missionary without thanking God that I


can be part of what they're doing by praying, giving, and going. Second, I cannot imagine my life or ministry without New Orleans Seminary, and our schools and seminaries are as strong as or stronger than they've ever been. We have a generation of scholars and teachers who give me hope for the future, doing exceptional work that's making a difference for me and other pastors and churches. Third, and above all, after a lifetime of Bible study I remain more convinced than ever that our doctrine is true to the Word of God, from Genesis to Revelation. Attacks and distractions are to be expected; this is, after all, spiritual warfare, and when you're serious about God, Satan is serious about you. But I'm deeply grateful for what we are and where we are, and not interested in going anywhere!

After an unforgettable VBS week, this Sunday morning we'll return to our study of Ezra. In Chapter 7 we meet someone who's been out of the picture so far, and find out why God's people need to be skilled in God's Word. We'll also be baptizing three new church members. On Sunday night we'll return to the Gospel of John and marvel at the Good Shepherd in Chapter 10. Don't miss it – I can't imagine being anywhere else!




They're Ba-ack - the Choir Returns!


