I appreciate the fact that my parents didn’t send me, they brought me, because they went every week too. It’s a terribly important thing for a child to see both his or her father and mother being faithful to and serving in the church. What I learned from that, without even realizing it at the time, is that there’s nothing in life any more important than the Lord, and His church. Leave your children a legacy that’s a blessing to be grateful for, not an obstacle to be overcome.

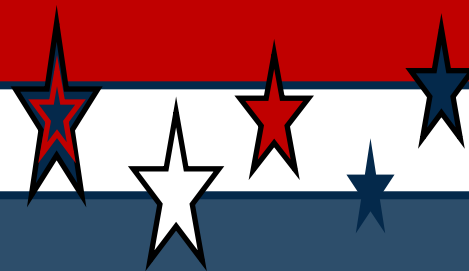

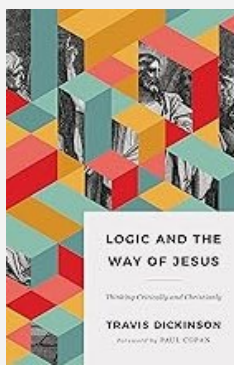
