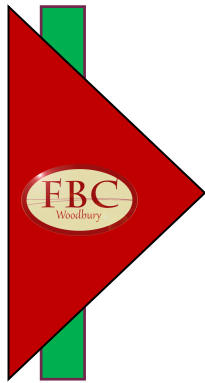




People occasionally say things like, “How wonderful that you have a commitment to your daughters and son-in-law and your grandkids! Isn’t it wonderful that you make them a priority and spend time with them whenever you can?” And for me the obvious answer is, “Have you met my daughters and son-in-law? Have you seen my grandkids?” You think I have to try to work up a commitment to them, to fret and strain to make them a priority and spend whatever time I can with them? Just go look at them! Talk to them a minute! All I have to do is look at them, and commitment and priority and the spending time with them whenever I can, all that just starts coming naturally—I can’t help it! We spend a lot of time gazing at our own navels, spiritually speaking, focusing on my faith, my commitment, what I’m doing for God, and so forth. What we need to do is start looking at Jesus. The author of Hebrews says to “run with endurance the race that is set before us” (vs. 1), and then he tells us how: “looking unto Jesus” (vs. 2) and “consider Him” (vs. 3). When you really seek Him and consider Him and study Him, the wonder and the worship and the commitment and the priority all start welling up naturally.

On Sunday morning we’ll look to Isaiah 65: in all the decisions we make, there is one powerful factor that determines whether we make the right choice or the wrong one. Be here and find out what it is! On Sunday night, Bro. Tony will have a Word from the Lord. Should you be here? Don’t make the wrong choice...

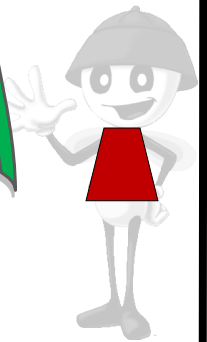

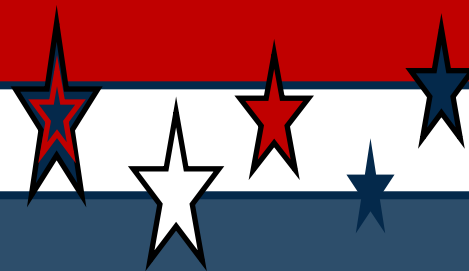

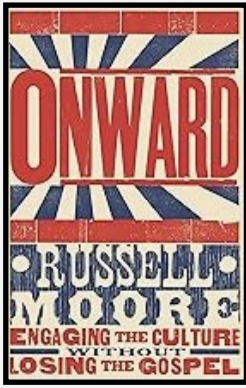
